The things you can experience in KAWAGOE



Traditional townscape

Roughly a 15-minute walk from Kawagoe Station. Once you clear through the hustle and bustle around the station, an old-fashioned Japanese cityscape will suddenly appear before you. We recommend changing into a rental kimono and taking pictures around the town.



Traditional craftsmanship

There are many craftsmen in Kawagoe who carry on traditional Japanese skills that have been passed down for hundreds of years. In the picture, starting from the left, you can see a soy sauce maker, sake maker, hanko(stamp) maker, and more. Come down to Kawagoe, a city of craftsmen, and interact with the craftsmen who live and work here.



Food&Drink

There are also many traditional Japanese eel restaurants, and many foreign guests are willing to even go out of their way to eat eel here. In the outskirts are tea fields, and you can drink tea made from the leaves picked there in Kawagoe. It's also an area famous for sweet potatoes, and you can enjoy sweet potato snacks and cooking that you won't find anywhere else in the world.
